The ACCES Clinical Engineering Professional of the Year Award will be presented annually to a member of the Biomedical Community in Atlantic Canada.

Potential candidates for consideration should include Clinical and Biomedical Engineering Technologists, Technicians and Engineers employed in the Atlantic Canada clinical community who have been nominated by their peers. This award will be presented to the professional who has distinguished themselves in one or more of the following areas:

- Scientific or technical abilities
- Exceptional service and/or technical skills
- Outstanding contributions to the improvement of health care technology
- Special achievements/developments in clinical or biomedical engineering
- Leadership, service and organizational skills that have contributed to the improvement of health care delivery in Atlantic Canada
- Prominence in organizations concerned with biomedical engineering at the local and/or national level
- Promotion of Clinical Engineering Profession
- Must be actively engaged in clinical/ biomedical engineering technology in Atlantic Canada
- Being a registered Technologist/Technician at the provincial level or a Professional Engineer in good standing with a provincial/national engineering society would be considered an asset

Additional Procedural Information:

The award consists of a certificate that will be presented to the successful candidate, if possible, at the annual ACCES Conference held in Atlantic Canada. Travel expenses, accommodations and conference fees will be provided to the recipient for him/her to attend the conference. Information on the award nomination process will be posted on the ACCES website in January of the current year and distributed to the biomedical community in Atlantic Canada. Applications will be available on the ACCES website only, although it is not required to be a member of ACCES in order to nominate a peer or to receive this award. When nominating a candidate please provide the name and contact information of their immediate manager/supervisor. Applications should be received by March 1st. It is at the discretion of the ACCES board to decide if any or all nominees meet the award criteria, and upon so, will select the successful candidate by March 31st.
