How do I qualify in Canada?

Three or more years of Clinical Engineering practice
Licensure in Canada as a Professional Engineer (P.Eng., ing., etc.,) in your respective Province of residence

What steps are in the process of Certification?

Successful completion of written multiple choice examination Successful completion of an oral examination given by two examiners

When can I apply?

Deadline for new candidates to apply: Typically is July 2021 (Exact Date TBD)

How much does it cost?

Application Fee: \$475 USD (one time fee)
Renewal Fee: \$150 USD (every 3 years)
